Guidance on format of submissions:

All papers are peer-reviewed. Acceptance depends on achieving the relevant standard and revisions may be required; the editor's decision is final.

- Submissions must be in English and typed in double-spacing.
- Submissions must be in **Word for Microsoft Office**.
- Word length: between 5000 and 7000 words, including abstract and figures but excluding references.
- Please avoid using footnotes; endnotes are permissible where essential.
- Include an abstract of up to 150 words.
- List up to six key words.
- Papers must use full academic referencing both in the text and in the list of references at the end of the paper. Please use the Harvard system (e.g. as described at the following link:
http://www.bournemouth.ac.uk/library/citing_references/docs/Citing_Refs.pdf)
- Permission to quote from or reproduce copyright material must be obtained before submission and acknowledged in the text. **Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce copyright material from other sources; the editor may require evidence of permissions.**
- Provide full details (names, addresses, affiliations) of all authors **on a separate page**. If there are multiple authors, indicate clearly the lead author for correspondence.
